

MA/RI SENIOR YOUTH CAMP RULES

THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY FROM THE TIME YOU REGISTER UNTIL YOU LEAVE.

DISMISSAL FROM EVENING SERVICE.

1. Do not leave the sanctuary at the end of service until the Camp director has dismissed campers.
2. You may go to the restroom during service only after receiving permission from camp counselor.
3. You must be accompanied by a camp counselor to leave sanctuary for any reason prior to dismissal.

CURFEW:

1. You must be in the room 1 hour after camp dismissal from evening service unless otherwise instructed.
2. Campers are not allowed to leave the grounds without the knowledge and consent of the camp director.
3. At no time shall any camper leave the grounds unless accompanied by an adult.

SCHEDULE:

1. All campers must participate in all camp activities. (i.e. classes, choir, recreation)

ACCOMODATION RULES:

2. No- switching rooms once assigned by camp registrar.
3. Campers are not to be in room during camp activities without a camp counselor's approval.
4. Rooms should be kept neat and clean.
5. All campers must vacate room 10 minutes prior to start time of any camp activity.
6. All campers must remain in their assigned rooms for sleeping.
7. All campers must be responsible for his/her own, clothing, luggage, and personal belongings.
8. Any individual choosing to deface the property or natural surroundings shall pay for damages incurred.

REST AND MEALS:

1. Attention is expected from all campers during any camp activity.
2. All campers must report to designated area for all meals.
3. Any camper who becomes seriously ill due to lack of sleep or inadequate meals will be subject to dismissal from camp after receiving medical attention.

MUSIC:

1. Approved Christian music only.
2. No radio stations, unless it is approved Christian programming.
3. NO LOUD MUSIC! Any camper not abiding by these rules will have their equipment taken for the duration of camp.

GIRL/BOY RELATIONSHIPS:

1. No physical contact with the opposite sex! (i.e. holding hands, hugging, kissing, etc.)
2. No camper is to be alone with another camper of the opposite sex at any time.
3. No boys in the girls' room and no girls in the boy's room at any time.

GIRLS/BOYS DRESS CODE:

1. Hem length of girl's skirts and dresses should be BELOW the knee while standing, sitting or walking. In addition, splits should go no higher than the knee.
2. No tight-fitting clothes.
3. No sleeveless or capped sleeved outfits.
4. Modest necklines, front and back, no low-cut necklines.
5. No attire that immodestly draws attention to the body by being too tight fitting. No sheer or see-through outfits or sleeves.
6. Girls should not wear pants or shorts.
7. Guys are not to wear shorts.
8. No shirts or blouses that expose the stomach. Also applies when arms are raised.
9. Proper undergarments must be worn.
10. No suggestive slogans on shirts or caps.

11. No jewelry or makeup, no colored fingernails/toenails.

Additional Dress Code Information: Bathrooms and showers are not connected to the dorm cabins, therefore campers will need to walk through the campground to get to the showers and bathrooms. Anytime a camper leaves their cabin they must be modestly dressed. Pajamas are not permitted to be worn outside of the dorms.

CAR KEYS OF ENROLLED CAMPERS

1. All car keys shall be turned in to the designated Campus Patrol.
2. The keys will be kept at the camp house until camper is ready to leave camp.

PROBATION OR DISMISSAL FROM CAMP

A. The penalty for violation of general camp rules shall be decided by the Executive Youth Camp Committee. The penalties include:

1. Verbal warning
2. Written warning
3. In Camp Probation

B. Violations to be considered by Camp Disciplinary Committee warranting the penalty of probation or dismissal:

1. Any student leaving camp premises without Executive Youth Camp Committee approval.
2. Any student conducting themselves in such a manner as to bring reproach upon the MA/RI District Youth Camp endeavor.
3. Specific activities subject to immediate dismissal, such as any of the following:
 - a. Possessing or using illegal drugs, alcoholic beverages or tobacco.
 - b. Sexual promiscuity
 - c. Possessing firearms, knives or any weapons
 - d. Absolute defiance of authority
 - e. Fighting
 - f. Possession of pornography
 - g. Leaving the dorm after curfew without permission.

C. The Penalty for offenses shall be decided upon by the Executive Youth Camp Committee. These will include:

1. Dismissal from Camp.
2. Dismissal from Camp and probation for one year.
3. Dismissal with indefinite suspension.

D. In the case that a camper is dismissed from the camp, the pastor and/or parents/guardian shall be contacted by Camp Principal or another member of Disciplinary Committee to arrange for immediate pick up of that camper.

ANY CAMPER NOT ABIDING BY THESE RULES WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISMISSAL FROM CAMP INCLUDING FORFEITURE OF TOTAL REGISTRATION FEE.
